ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS AND LEGAL NOTICES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the North Davis Sewer District (OWNER) invites and will receive sealed Bids from Qualified Contractors at 4252 West 2200 South, Syracuse, Utah 84075, at or before the hour of 2:00 p.m., local time, on January 5, 2022, for construction of the **MUTTON HOLLOW REPLACEMENT** project. Bids will be received, and time clock recorded by the OWNER's representative. Bids received after 2:00 p.m. will be deemed late. Immediately after the Bid closing time, timely Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

**PLEASE NOTE: DUE TO COVID-19, ADDITIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY MEASURES ARE REQUIRED. A TEMPERATURE CHECK WILL BE CONDUCTED AT ENTRY AND FACEMASK WILL BE REQUIRED.**

- A. The Work includes: the furnishing of all labor, materials, and equipment for the supply, delivery, fabrication, installation, testing, and other materials and services required for the **MUTTON HOLLOW REPLACEMENT** project. Specific features include, but are not limited to:
1. Removal, and replacement and abandon-in-place, pressure grouting, of existing manhole(s) and gravity sewer in public ROW, and NDSO easements.
  2. Open-cut construction of 30-inch diameter CCFRP and 12-inch PVC gravity sewer in public rights-of-way (ROW) and in NDSO easements across private property.
  3. Stream Crossing open-cut removal and replacement of existing sanitary sewer and stream bypass for the North Fork Holmes Creek. North Fork Holmes Creek bypass and protection crossing.
  4. Location, inspection, open-cut construction, and reconnection of existing service laterals to constructed sewers in existing and new alignments.
  5. Cleaning of sewer pipes, manholes, and structures, CCTV inspection, bypass pumping, traffic control, excavation and backfilling, and surface restoration.
  6. Coordination with utility owners and performance of work in accordance with Dominion Energy, Holmes Creek Irrigation District, and Davis Weber Counties Canal Company.

7. Coordination with ROW owners for surface restoration, traffic control, road cut, and encroachment permit(s) and coordination with private property owners for access and maintenance of service.
8. The Site of the Work is located in Davis County, Utah. and public right-of-way of Kaysville, and Layton City, NDSO Easements across private property and the Davis County Flood Control District.

A **mandatory pre-bid conference** will commence at 10:00 a.m. local time on December 16, 2021 at the North Davis Sewer District, 4252 West 2200 South, Syracuse, Utah 84075.

The Work shall be Substantially Complete within 338 days after the commencement date of the PNTP. The Work shall reach Final Completion within 368 after the PNTP date.

Bids shall be accompanied by a proposal guarantee in the form of a cashier's or a certified check, cash, or Bidder's Bond in an amount not less than 10 percent of the Bid, made payable to or for the benefit of the North Davis Sewer District.

Neither the OWNER nor the ENGINEER has any responsibility for the accuracy, completeness, or sufficiency of any Bid Documents obtained from any source other than the source indicated in these documents. Obtaining these documents from any other source(s) may result in obtaining incomplete and inaccurate information. Bidders are hereby advised that obtaining these documents from any source other than directly from the source listed herein may also result in Bidders' failure to receive addenda, corrections, or other revisions to these documents that may be issued.

The OWNER is committed to promoting full and equal business opportunities for all persons doing business in Davis and Weber Counties. The successful bidder acknowledges that the OWNER has an obligation to ensure that public funds are not used to subsidize private
